

Construct a family purpose statement that will lay out goals and standards and serve as a guide moving forward.

KUUMBA - CREATIVITY

Build on family relations and design a creation that is representative of the individual and the collective.


MISSION.

PARTICIPANTS REQUIREMENTS

Full families must participate in the program. However, FAMILIES OF HARAMBEE, is an inclusive program that both recognizes and celebrates the diversity found within families. All family types are welcomed to participate, including:




